PREPARATION AND PRESENTATION OF WINE

The rose wine “DOMAINE DE LA COLOMBE” is produced from the Grenache and Cinsault grape varieties, which are grown in the vineyards of the Var department, in the south of France. Located in the vicinity of Saint-Maximin-la-Sainte-Baume village, the vineyard covers approximately 30 ha. Situated at an altitude between 360 and 420 meters above sea level, the surrounding soils are mainly comprised of a mixture of clay, limestone, bauxite, and marble sands such as those common to the Sainte Victoire area. IGP Country Wines like the “DOMAINE DE LA COLOMBE”, according to French regulations, come from a particular, officially designated area. Produced from the best grapes from their area of origin, grape varieties must satisfy all regulatory conditions to ensure that standards of production quality, such as limited yields per hectare and pre-market testing.
