WINE PREPARATION

It is located near Rognes in the Bouches du Rhône, between the chain of Côtes and Trévaresse. Its rosé is one of the wines of Provence classified in the Coteaux Aix-en-Provence appellation. Rosé wines produced in this region are supple and fruity. The Domaine Saint Esteve rosé wine comes from the practice of organic farming. Organic agricultural products are grown without fertilizers or chemicals. They are subject to regular controls by ECOCERT.
